Appellation : Côtes de Bordeaux

The vineyard extends on 20 acres, half of which dates back to the early 1960's, is planted at a high density of 5.500 to 6.200 vines per hectare.

A portion sits atop a gravel plateau while the rest is on steep of clay and limestone. The south-south exposure ensures a maximum amount of sunshine;

Planted grape varieties: 70 % Merlot, 20 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 10 % Cabernet Franc

Hand harvesting: the different parcels are vinified in small stainless–steel vats, with own temperature control

Ageing in French oak barrels (50% new barrels) during 12 months and 3 months in vats before bottling.

No fining, no filtration. .

The wines are stored in an air-conditioned building

Blending 2010 - 85% Merlot, 10 % Cabernet sauvignon, 5 % Cabernet franc

It should be drunk over the next several years.
