James Suckling – 91

A juicy fruity red with plum, stone and walnut character. Medium to full body. Juicy finish. Nicely done for the appellation.

Decanter 90

Clear charred damson on the nose, plenty of fruit to balance out the charred oak notes. A touch of heat on the finish but overall this is a successful and has a personality. Drink to 2022-2028

Jeb Dunnock - 90

Always made charmer, the 2019 Château Le Doyenné offers a ripe, complex, medium bodied style that carries pretty red and black fruits, herbes de Provence, and flowery incense aromas and flavors. I love its texture, and if it shows this well from the bottle, it will be the finest vintage of this cuvée I've tasted.

Vinous- Neal Martin – 89

The 2019 Le Doyenne has a vivid bouquet with overt, flowers scents, quite Margaux-like in style. The palate offers high-toned red fruits, rather grainy texture with an attractive spiciness, almost ash-like on the structured finish. Fine.
